Pacific Gateway Harbor Worksource Center, in partnership with Southern California Regional Occupational Center





(SoCal ROC), has offered training opportunities for individuals interested in becoming Certified Medical Assistants and Registered Dental Assistants. As a requirement, students must complete 160 hours of unpaid externship and apply their skills at job sites in the LA county area as part of their training. Only trainees who complete the accredited courses and pass the State Board Exam are eligible to receive a certificate of competency from SoCal ROC. The trainees are expected to graduate in July 2021.

Harbor Worksource Center Career specialists will provide career counseling, employment guidance, workshops, interviewing techniques, and job search strategies to ensure the success of the trainees.

Relativity Space Recruits Pacific Gateway Connected Talent

Relativity

Relativity Space is a private American Aerospace manufacturing company headquartered in Long Beach, California, founded in 2015 by Tim Ellis and Jordan Noone. Relativity is developing manufacturing technologies, launch vehicles, and rocket engines for commercial orbital launch services using state of the art 3D printing techniques, Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning.

Pacific Gateway held a special recruitment event in October for Relativity Space and was joined by Natalie Estrella from Talent Acquisition and Dr. Chris Dodson, Director of Propulsion. Natalie is Relativity Space's lead technical recruiter who has worked in the past with Virgin Hyperloop. Before joining Relativity Space, Dr. Dodson was an early employee at SpaceX, where he worked on testing their Draco engines and Cargo Dragon spacecraft propulsion systems.

The event was held virtually and was exceptionally well attended; Pacific Gateway has served an essential role in the transition of layoff impacted aerospace workers throughout Southern California and is working hard to retain talent in the local market.

Eligible participants can receive an average of 500 hours of temporary work at approved work sites within the serving area.

Funding for these programs ends December 31, 2020 or until all funds are expended, whichever comes first.

COVID Programs

Currently, the Harbor Gateway WorkSource Center is offering two specifically designed programs serving residents of San Pedro, Wilmington Harbor City and Harbor Gateway. Both of the programs are for individuals whose jobs have been impacted (laid off or experienced a reduction in hours) by COVID-19.

\$800 FOR RESIDENTS IN NEED

This program was developed to serve vulnerable populations including survivors of human trafficking and domestic violence, English Language Learners, Homeless, individuals seeking to re-enter the workforce, Veterans and Persons with Disabilities. Participants are eligible to receive up to \$800 in reimbursements which may include rental assistance, utility assistance or child care assistance based on their eligibility. We have funding for 15 participants.

Safety and Disaster Service Worker Training

In order to mitigate the continued and extensive losses incurred by California businesses and communities from the current coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19), the State of California Employment Development Department (EDD) has announced the "COVID-19 National Dislocated Worker Grant" (NDWG)". Harbor WorkSource Center is one of the agencies responsible for recruiting, assessing, and enrolling eligible participants into temporary employment opportunities and support service, as well as ensure all eligible COVID19 NDWG participants receive safety training and disaster service worker training. In an effort to accomplish their goal, the Harbor WorkSource Center developed an online curriculum for Safety and Disaster Service Worker Training on the Metrix Learning Portal. During the 6 hour, self-paced training, individuals will learn the requirements and standards associated with OSHA and workplace safety. The course outlines the history and mission of the Occupational and Health Administration and its importance to workers.
