Subject:	PACIFIC GATEWAY POLICIES

BACKGROUND

Pacific Gateway Workforce Development Board (PGWDB) is kept abreast of legislation, both local and national, with potential impact to the Workforce Development Board (WDB) activity, funding, performance measures, or other areas. With the final release of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) regulations in August 2016, Pacific Gateway initiated the review of its operational policies to ensure the agency is in full compliance and make use of new WIOA opportunities.
